



Street Sweeping

The Solid Waste/Street Sweeping Division provides sweeping service for Residential, Commercial, and main arterial streets within the city limits. Approximately 180 curb miles are swept twice a month.

Street Sweeping Tips

Did you know that sweeping your leaves into the street can cause problems with your storm drain and sometimes causes flooding during the rainy season? It is time consuming and our sweeper does not have the capacity for picking up leaves without having to make several trips to empty them. If you have a problem with leaves, here are some ways to dispose of them.

1. You can sign up at the Finance Department for an additional greenwaste container for the heavy leaf season. Additional cans are \$8.00 a month and will be added onto your utility bill after delivery. Just call the Solid Waste office when you are ready to have the additional container removed and the charges will be removed from your billing.
2. You can dispose of the leaves from your gutter in your regular greenwaste container.

Frequently Asked Questions

Why wasn't sweeping completed in front of my home/business?

It is usually because items such as vehicles, bicycles, toys, basketball hoops, and refuse containers are blocking the roadway. Low hanging trees and shrubs can prevent the sweeper from cleaning in front of your home. **It is the property owner/residents responsibility to maintain a minimum clearance of 14 feet as per City of Tulare Municipal Code, Section 8.32.080 Duty to trim trees.**

What can I do to help the street sweeper?

Keeping the roadway in front of your house/business free of large objects and obstructions is the best way to assist street sweeping. Large sticks, branches, and pine needles will clog and jam the operating system.

What about sweeping up leaves?

During the winter months, the focus of the City's street sweeping efforts is leaf removal to help keep the drains clear. The sweeper cannot pick up large loads. Please place leaves from trees in your greenwaste container.

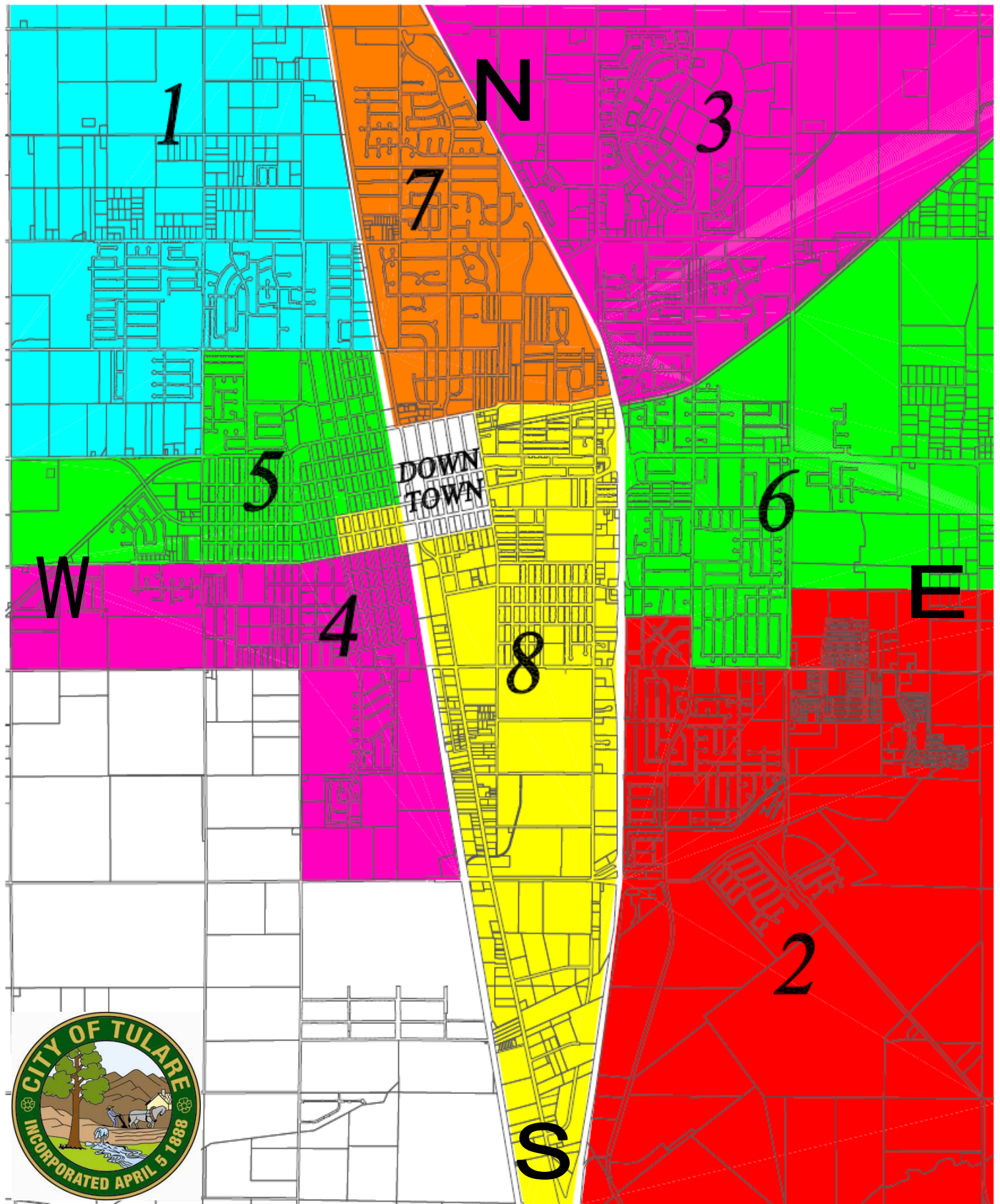


Match your area on the map with the route number on the calendar to determine your service *days.
